

## INFORMED CONSENT FOR PEPTIDE THERAPY

Specific Benefits and General Information of Growth Hormone Secretagogue (GHS) Peptides:

• CJC- 1295, Tesamorelin, GHRP2, and GHRP6 are an analog of the growth hormone releasing hormone (GHRH) which increases endogenous growth hormone release. Ipamorelin and Ibutamoren, are selective ghrelin secretagogues which also encourage endogenous growth hormone release. GHS peptides increase serum growth hormone levels and thereby increase serum levels of IGF1 and IGFBP3.

Benefits and General Information of Tissue Repair Peptides
BPC-157 is a partial sequence of body protection compound (BPC) found in human gastric juice. BPC-157 can be used to accelerate healing of a variety of wounds including tendon-to-bone healing and healing of damaged ligaments and acts systematically in the digestive tract to combat leaky gut, IBS, gastrointestinal cramps and Crohn's disease.

• GHK-Cu is a naturally occurring copper peptide which is naturally produced in many tissues in the body. Copper peptides are like this are naturally occurring protein fragments that have high affinity for copper ions, which are critical to normal body function. GHK-Cu has a variety of roles in the human body including, but not limited to promoting activation of wound healing, attracting immune cells, anti-oxidant and anti-inflammatory effects, and stimulating collagen and glycosaminoglycan synthesis to help reduce wrinkles and fine lines in skin.

## **Benefits of Bremelanotide PT-141**

• PT-141 is also known as Bremelanotide and is most known for its ability to treat sexual dysfunction in men and women. It is a derivative of Melanotan 2. It's a synthetic peptide blend, as it isn't naturally produced in the body like growth hormones are. PT 141 was developed from the Melanotan 2 hormone which is known to help darken pigmentation of the skin. • For GHS peptides possible adverse reactions include injection site redness, flushing, transient high blood sugar, development of antibodies to GHS peptides, and water retention. These side effects are dose related and usually eliminated by adjusting the dosage. This drug should not be used in patients with known cancer.

• For tissue repair peptides possible adverse reactions include redness, itching, irritation, or inflammation at the site of injection, nausea or upset stomach

• For PT-141 possible adverse reactions include redness, itching, irritation, or inflammation at the site of injection, flushing, nausea, and vomiting.

• For Thymosin Alpha-1, possible adverse reactions include redness and discomfort at the injection site, muscle atrophy, multiple joint aches and pains, and swelling and rash of the hand.
